

THE LAKE ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

The William "Chief" Fetters Scholarship

The Lake Athletic Booster Club will award four **\$1,000.00** scholarships each year to four Lake High School graduating senior student/athletes. For purposes of this scholarship, student/athletes shall include all sports participants: athletes, managers, statisticians, (including "Mat Stats") and student videographers.

The purpose of this scholarship is to reward student/athletes for their participation and accomplishments in athletics, their academic performance, their character, their leadership, and their service to the community.

To apply for this scholarship:

- 1. Applicant must be a Lake High School graduating senior.
- 2. Applicant must have a minimum 2.5 grade point average (GPA) after seven semesters and must exhibit good character.
- 3. Applicant must have donated time and/or talent in service to the community volunteer work at school, church, nursing home, charitable organization, etc.
- 4. Applicant must be admitted to or planning to attend a 2-year or 4-year college in a degree program.
- 5. Applicant must complete the application, submit a copy of his/her transcript, and write one essay. All information must be legible, correct, and verifiable.
- Completed application must be returned to the Lake High School Athletic Director's office by Monday APRIL 3^{rd,} 2023
 Its incomplete applications will not be considered
 - ** Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 7. The awarding of the scholarship will be based on an objective assessment of all of the information provided by the applicants. Points will be awarded for each category of the application (participation in athletics, awards, community service/participation, leadership, scholarship).
- Essays will be awarded 1 10 points from each committee member and the applicant will receive the average number of points that were assigned. Interviews will be awarded 1 – 20 points by each committee member and the applicant will also receive the average number of points assigned for the interview portion of the process.
- 9. Presentation of the winners will take place as part of the Lake High School Senior Recognition Dinner in May of each year.
- 10. The actual scholarship award will be in the form of a **\$1000.00** book grant check with the student/athlete as the payee. In addition each winner will receive a commemorative plaque and his/her name will be placed on the William "Chief" Fetters Scholarship Winners plaque displayed at Lake High School.
- 11. Applicants must take a minimum of eight (8) credit hours in college each term and maintain an acceptable non-probationary status with the institution they attend.
- 12. If any winner is unable to accept his/her scholarship award, it shall pass to the next runner-up, but only in the summer following graduation.
