

Salute to Service Scholarship Application

This \$1,000 scholarship is for one year and is non-renewable. The purpose of this scholarship to recognize the deserving immediate family members of Veterans by financially assisting with their higher education and career goals. The scholarship will be chosen by the Salute to Service scholarship committee and will be awarded at the conclusion of the school year at the Senior Recognition Banquet. The money will be sent directly to the college or trade school.

Application deadline is **Wednesday March 29, 2023.**

Requirements:

- The applicant must have an immediate family member (father, mother, step-father, step-mother, sibling) that has served or is currently serving in one of the six branches of the United States Armed Forces; Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, Coast Guard or Space Force. Eligibility includes Active Duty, Reserve Components or Veteran status.
- Must be a Lake High School senior pursuing higher education at an accredited college, university, or trade/technical school
- Completed Application with required signatures
- Official transcript
