COMMUNITY

Lake Township is located in the northeastern quadrant of Ohio. It is approximately 43 miles south of Cleveland. Lake Township is 33 square miles with a population of 25,890 people. The population makeup is 74% suburban, 24% rural and 1% farm.

SCHOOL

Lake Middle/High School has approximately 1,700 students, grades 7-12. Our grading period consists of two semesters. The school CEEB/ACT/SAT code is **362535**. Approximately 72% of our seniors go to a four-year college and approximately 16% of our seniors go to a two-year college or technical school. The composite ACT average is 21.6.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students must graduate with a minimum of 21 credits. The required courses are as follows: four credits (4 full years) of English, one credit of Literature Workshop or Foreign Language, three credits of Science, four credits (4 full years) of Mathematics, one-half credit of Physical Education (students earning PE Waivers would be exempt from earning the PE credit), one-half credit of Health, one credit of Fine Arts, three credits of Social Studies, four credits of additional courses (4.5 credits with the PE Waiver), and successful completion of the Ohio Department of Education graduation requirements.

GPA is determined by non-weighted grade calculations.
